## TYPES OF WEDDING AVAILABLE

1. Civil Wedding (Legal)

2. Catholic Religious Wedding (Legal and Sacramental)

# LEGAL CEREMONY - REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

# (foreigners and/or Dominicans with dual nationality):

- Sworn statement of single status
- Copy of the bride and groom's passports
- Divorce certificate (if applicable).
- Birth certificate (with parents' names)
- Copy of the passports of two witnesses (not relatives)
- Death certificate (if widowed).
- Cost of the ceremony USD \$1003,00

#### Legalisation and Translation:

- Hague Convention countries: Apostille + translation into Spanish
- Countries outside the Hague Convention: Legalisation at the Dominican consulate + translation into Spanish Originals and copies must be presented in person.

In advance:

- Book at least 6 months prior to the wedding
- Ceremony in Spanish with possibility of translation
- Subject to availability of the judge

#### CATHOLIC WEDDING -

#### Jesús Maestro Parish Church - REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Letter of permission from the local parish priest (at least 4 months in advance)
- Pre-marriage survey and approval from the diocese or transfer of documents from the diocese of residence
- Birth certificates of both parties (certified and legalised)
- Passports or identity cards of both parties
- Baptismal certificates for both parties (with marginal notes and issued less than 6 months previously)
- Confirmation certificates and first communion certificates
- Certificate of premarital course
- Civil divorce certificate (if applicable)
- Ecclesiastical annulment certificate (if applicable)
- Passport or identity card of the witnesses
- Interview with the parish priest (prior coordination)

- Civil marriage certificate (if applicable)
- Death certificate of previous spouse (if applicable)
- Letter of dispensation (if applicable)
- Completion of the official form by the couple
- Confession required before the sacrament

Send these documents scanned by email followed by hard copy from the corresponding diocese. Local parish email: pjesusmaestro1@gmail.com

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Catholic weddings are not held on the beach
- Permitted locations: church, gazebo, terrace or garden (with permission from the bishop)
- Rehearsal organised by the hotel

#### • Mass is optional.

# WEDDINGS FOR DOMINICAN NATIONALS - REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Identity cards of both parties
- Death certificate (if applicable)
- Legal declaration if married under separation of property
- Divorce certificate (if applicable)
- Two witnesses who are not related to the couple up to the third degree
