LEGAL CEREMONY FOR MEXICAN NATIONALS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Be at least 18 years old
 - Marriage application
 - Certified birth certificates
 - Valid official ID
 - Recent medical tests
 - Two witnesses each for bride and groom
 - Divorce certificate, if applicable
 - Death certificate, if spouse is deceased
 - Certificate of no outstanding alimony
 - The bride and groom and their 4 witnesses must arrive at the hotel at least 3 business days before the wedding
- Important: The tests and the judge's fee are included in the price of the legal ceremony

LEGAL CEREMONY FOR MEXICAN NATIONALS WITH FOREIGNERS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Be at least 18 years old
 - Marriage application
 - Certified birth certificates
 - Naturalisation certificate (if applicable)
 - Valid official ID
 - Recent medical tests
 - Two witnesses each for bride and groom
 - Divorce certificate, if applicable
 - Death certificate of deceased spouse, if applicable
 - Certificate of no outstanding alimony
 - The bride and groom and their 4 witnesses must arrive at the hotel at least 3 business days before the wedding
- Important: The tests, apostille, translation, and judge's fee are included in the price of the legal ceremony.

LEGAL CEREMONY FOR FOREIGNERS REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Marriage application
 - Birth certificate
 - Valid official ID
 - Recent medical tests
 - Two witnesses each for bride and groom
 - Divorce certificate, if applicable
 - Death certificate, if spouse is deceased
 - Certificate of no outstanding alimony
 - The bride and groom and their 4 witnesses must arrive at the hotel at least 3 business days before the wedding
